TOUR DE MISSISSAUGA 2011 ON SEPT. 18

Amy Webster once said, "If you enjoy riding a bicycle, the sound of a car door opening in front of you is similar to the sound of a gun being cocked."

To enable safety in Mississauga, the City installed a myriad of paths throughout the municipality.

Nonetheless, aside from safety, these bike paths promote recreational fun, exercise and adventure. The potential to make hundreds of new friends, particularly during events like the Tour de Mississauga 2011, which is an annual cycling tour for residents and visitors.

Last year some people were even riding recumbent bikes, while others rode hybrids.



This year, it will be launched from Celebration Square on September 18. The starting times depend on the routes taken:

- ▶ The Challenge Road Ride, which is a 100 Kilometre ride, will leave at 8:00 a.m.
- ▶ The Signature Ride, which is a 60 Kilometre ride, will leave at 8:30 a.m.
- ▶ The Family Ride, which is a 30 Kilometre ride, will leave at 9:30 a.m.

Organizers are requesting that bikers arrive an hour before their departure time, or 30 minutes before if the package is picked up on Saturday, September 17.
